Installing the Vivi Application

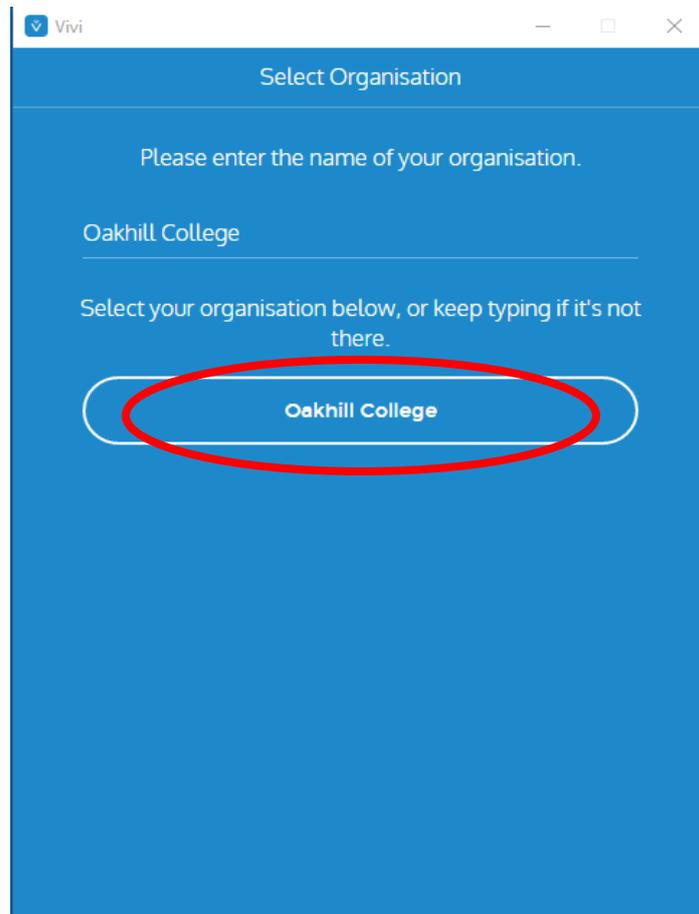
1. Firstly, Download the Vivi Application. To download the Vivi, go to the following website
<http://get.vivi.io>

For Windows users, this link will automatically download the installer and for Mac users, you will be directed to the App Store

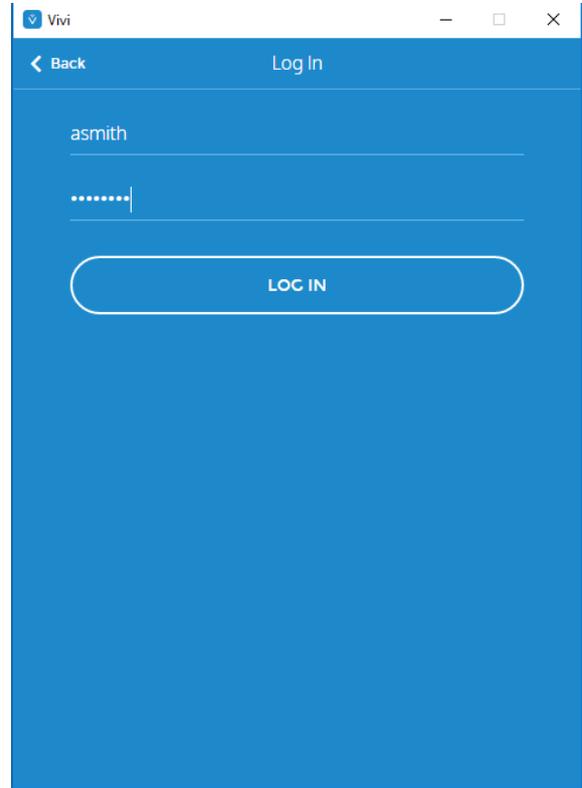
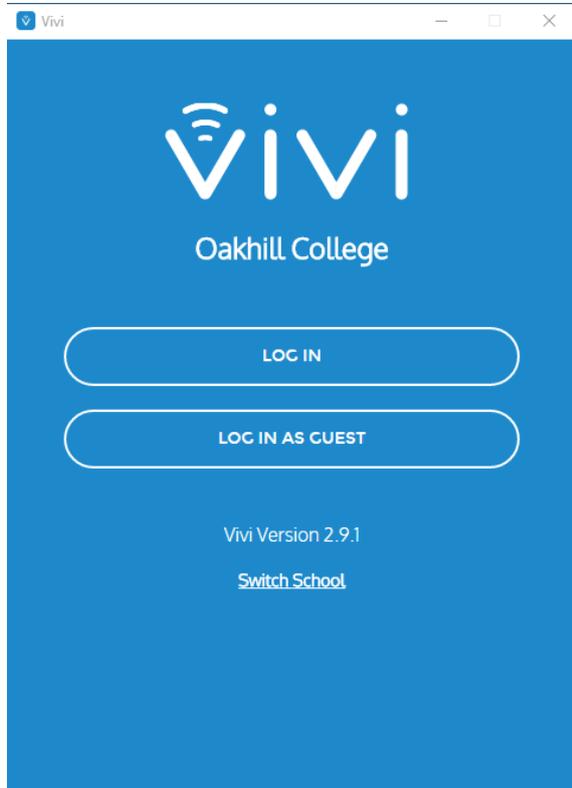
Alternatively, you can download the App from <https://www.viviaustralia.com.au/downloads>

Vivi is also available from the App Store for iOS Users and the Play Store for Android Users.

2. Once you have installed the application, open it up and this window will appear.
Type in the text field and then select the organisation name which is: **Oakhill College**



3. Log in with your Oakhill Username and Password



Wireless Display in the Classroom

- 1) Turn **ON** your Classroom Projector

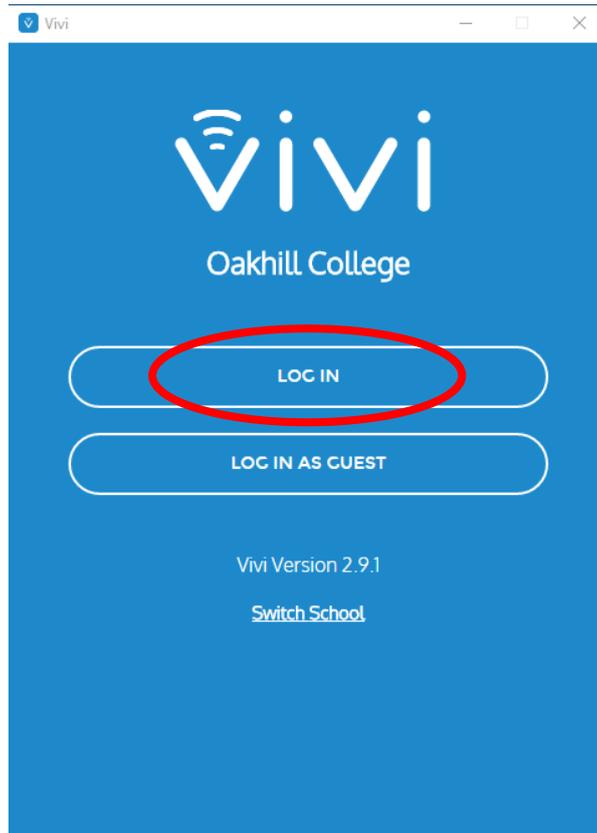


- 2) Choose your source on the control panel. The corresponding button on every control panel will be labelled 'V' for Vivi (Circled in Red). Press the button to choose the source.

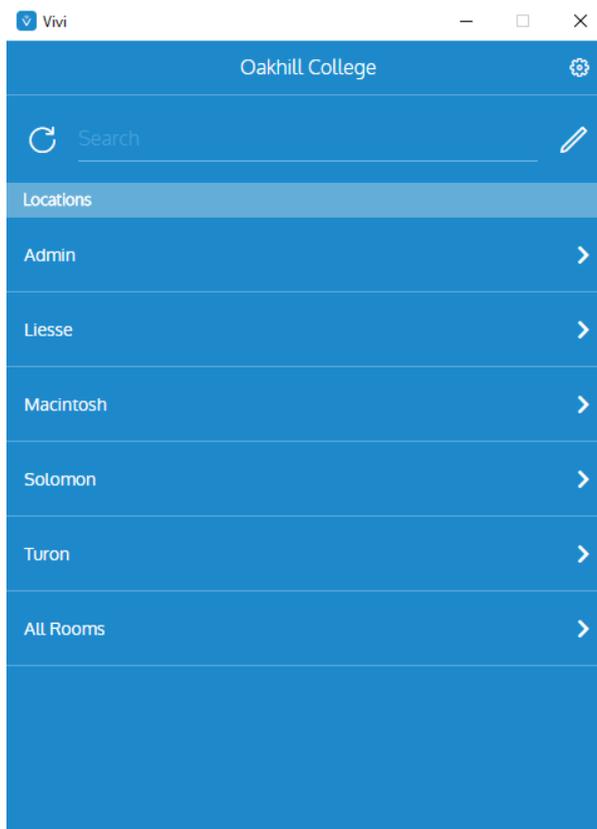
- 3) You will then be presented a screen that looks like this



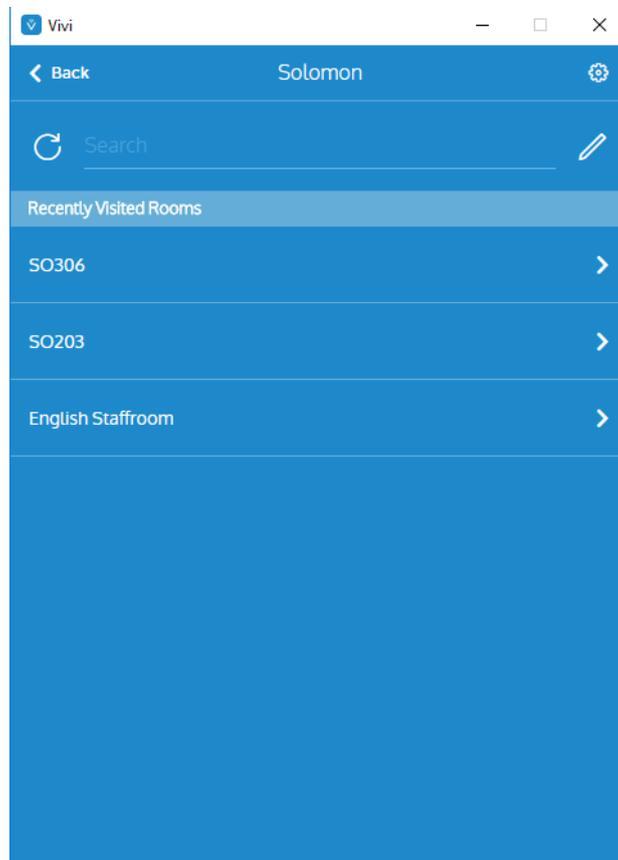
4) Now, back to your computer. Open the Vivi App and log in with your Oakhill Username and Password.



5) You will then see this screen. We have grouped the Vivi Boxes into buildings. Select the relevant building



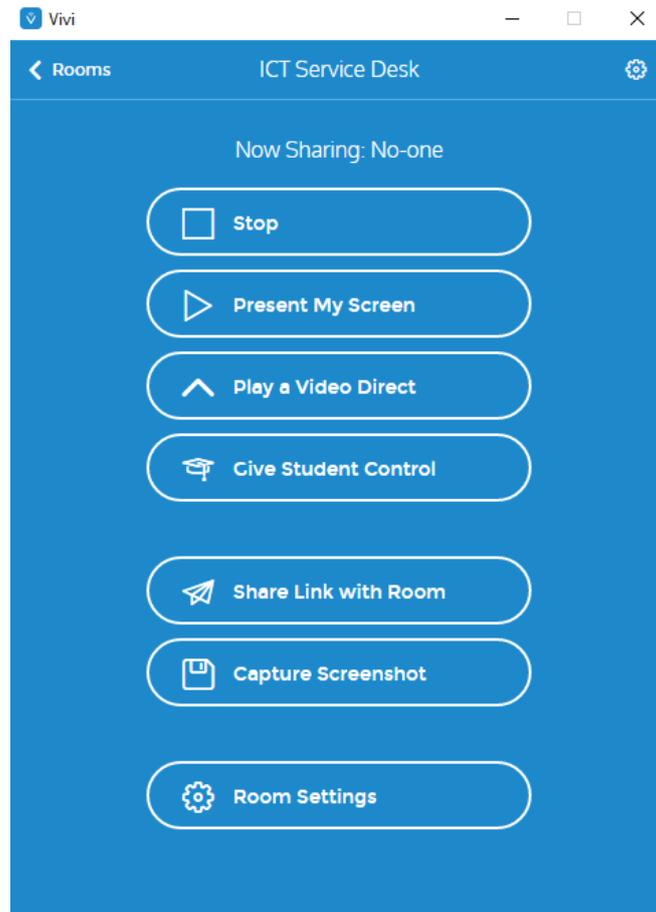
- 6) Each Vivi Box has been named by the Classroom it is in e.g. SO203. Select the relevant room. *(Please note that Vivi has not been installed in every classroom at this point. It will be gradually rolled out as the year goes on.)*



If you are unsure of which Vivi to connect to, the name of that specific box is on the Vivi Home Screen.



7) Once you have selected the relevant Classroom, you will be presented with these options.

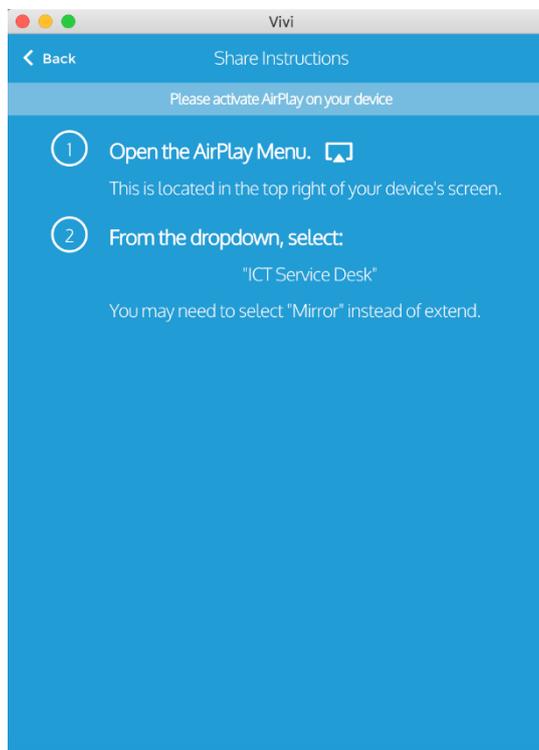


a) WINDOWS USERS

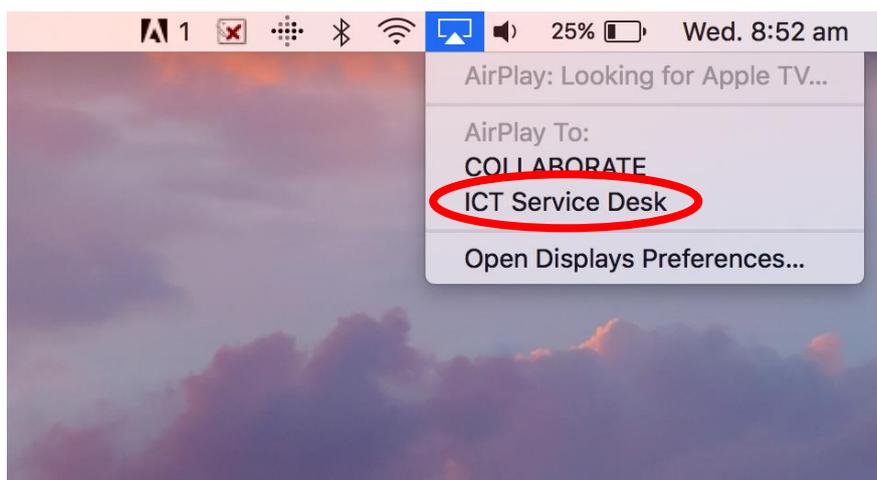
Windows users simply select 'Present My Screen' and your laptop screen will display.

b) MAC USERS

For mac users, there is another step involved in this process. You need to activate AirPlay on your device. Firstly, you will see this screen.



Then you will need to go to the AirPlay menu at the top of your screen or in your System Preferences and select the relevant Vivi Box.



You will now see your laptop display on the screen.

NB: You can mirror or extend your display the same way you would have been doing it up until this point.

Vivi Features

Vivi is capable of more than just showing your display on another screen. Some of the features that come with Vivi are:

Play A Video Direct: Play a video directly from the internet (such as YouTube). This feature gives high quality video play. You can also continue using your device while a video plays on the room's main TV or Projector screen.

Give Student Control: You will see a list of all connected students in the room who you can handover screen sharing.

Share Link with Room: Share an internet link with everyone in the room. This link will be displayed on all connected devices in the room.

ClickView Integration: Play a video directly from ClickView. This feature gives you the option to continue using your device while a ClickView film plays directly to the Main Display in the room.

Capture a Screenshot: You will be able to capture a screenshot of what is currently on your screen. You are able to annotate over the top of your screenshot and save a copy for later review. Students will also be able to capture a screenshot of the displayed content. They can also annotate over their screenshot.
